Sample Assignment: Leadership Book Review

Book Review Presentation

Instructions

You will make a five to ten-minute presentation (video or another format, if you wish) to the class covering the key points of a leadership or management book that you choose to read. **The instructor needs to pre-approve the book you will use.** You will be expected to cover the following items:

- The key points or ideas that the author(s) presented
- Your impressions of those ideas
- Your thoughts regarding how the author(s)'s ideas fit into organizational leadership
- Your assessment of the overall quality of the book.
